1. **Pencils for Testing:** Students must bring their own sharpened No. 2 pencils for all in-class assessments and state testing. This ensures that scholars are ready to work without interruptions and can participate fully in all academic activities, including state and classroom assessments.
2. **Home Computer and Internet Access:** The school has moved away from distributing Chromebooks for students to take home. We will, however, be assigning homework that students must have a device to complete at home. All students are required to have access to a home computer for homework, research, and skill practice. This is essential for completing assignments on time and supporting ongoing learning outside the classroom. There are several affordable Chromebook options available to students and families. A list has been provided at the end of this document for your convenience.
